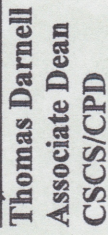

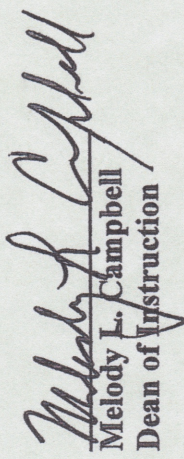

The official transcript will be mailed directly to the student (in a separately sealed envelope) and/or directly to the institution specified by the student on the request form. Note that Colleges and Universities require that a transcript be submitted in a sealed envelope to be considered official, and many institutions require that the transcript be sent directly from the sending institution, not from the student. This requirement is intended to ensure that the information has not been compromised in any way.

A student can receive two official transcripts at no cost to them. More than two copies will be charged to the student at the rate of \$5.00 per copy.

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
